Background

Foundation Stage

2. 2006 was the fourth year of the Foundation Stage Profile, an assessment which is reported at the end of the Reception year. The profile captures the six areas of learning of the Foundation Stage curriculum as a set of 13 assessment scales.

Key Stage 2

4. Key Stage 2 assessments for Year 6 children took place in May 2006. The results for individual schools can be found in the Primary Performance Tables that have been made available by the DfES and are enclosed with this report (see Appendix 1). Four measures are used for comparison: the overall percentage of children gaining the expected level of Level 4 and above in each subject, the average points score, the sum of the test percentages and the overall value added score.

In the past four years, in all subjects Dudley results have risen and been closing the gap with national averages.

In 2006, the attainment gap has been closed in English and science, and is 1% below the national average in mathematics.

The 2005-2006 Key Stage 1 to Key Stage 2 value added score shows a slight decrease. Value added is a measure of children's progress from the end of one Key Stage to the next. This is a reflection of the national picture.

In 2006, the Key Stage 3 results indicate that the number of pupils attaining a Level 5+ in English decreased by 3%. The number of pupils attaining Level 5+ in mathematics increased by 1% in 2006 and in science increased by 2%.

Results in science are 1% below national averages, 2% below in English and 3% in mathematics. The average points score increased by 0.3 points.

7. Dudley school sixth forms vary considerably in size. The DfES 2006 achievement and attainment tables record the following numbers of 16 to 18-year-olds on roll in the schools: Bishop Milner 149, Oldswinford Hospital 260 and Ellowes Hall 60. The Dudley average point score per student and per examination are above the Black Country average, but below the national average. Results at all three schools show an upward trend over the last four years. The average point score per student improved significantly in all three schools between 2005 and 2006. Ofsted has ceased to monitor the sixth form at Ellowes Hall, which was deemed to be unsatisfactory in an inspection report of November 2004, but was judged to be satisfactory by HMI in the spring of 2006.
