Hello Kay,

I am a little concerned that we are approaching 'saturation' point with mobile traders in the town centres. These mobile traders add considerably to the 'street clutter' of the highway and obstruction of the highway is one of the main sources of complaint that we receive from pedestrians in town centre areas.

Given that there is a dedicated market place in Dudley, with presumably stalls available to rent, I can see no advantage to having another mobile trader in place on the pedestrianised area of the town, increasing vehicle movement in an area where vehicles are generally prohibited.
