**Background**

**Foundation Stage**

2. 2005 was the third year of the Foundation Stage Profile, an assessment which is reported at the end of the Reception year. Dudley schools returned their school results at the end of June and a return was made to the DfES. At the request of the Borough’s schools, a Foundation Stage Profile mean was calculated for each school and for Dudley as a whole.

3. In 2005, schools were only required to report to the DfES on teacher assessments. Therefore, the results below are based only upon teacher assessments and not, as previously, task and test results.

The results for the Borough in 2005 have increased by 2% in writing and mathematics, and remained the same in reading and science. Nationally, results rose by 1% in mathematics, but remained at 2004 levels in all other subjects (see Appendices 1 and 1a)

Whilst these results remain below the national averages, in the past three years, Dudley's performance has seen the gap reduced by 1% in reading, writing and mathematics.

## Key Stage 2

4. Key Stage 2 assessments for Year 6 children took place in May 2005. The results for individual schools can be found in the Primary Performance Tables that have been made available by the DfES and are enclosed with this report (see Appendices 2 and 2a). Four measures are used for comparison: the overall percentage of children gaining the expected level of Level 4 and above in each subject, the average points score, the sum of the test percentages and the overall value added score.

In the past three years, English and mathematics have seen a closing of the gap to national averages. The number of pupils attaining Level 4+ in English has risen by 7% and in 2005 resulted in Dudley matching the national average (79%). In mathematics, the rise in the same period has been 5%, resulting in 2005 performance at 2% below the national average. Science results over the same period have consolidated at the 85% Level 4+ achieved in 2005, which is 1% from the national average. Comparison with our statistical neighbours shows us to be =7/11 for English, 9/11 for mathematics and =8/11 for science.

The value added trend Key Stage 1 to Key Stage 2 has risen from 99.8 (2003) to 99.9 (2005). Dudley's value added scores for 2003 and 2004 were in line with the national trend. In 2005, value added was below the national average of 100.2. Provisional data provided by the DfES had rounded Dudley's score of 99.95 up to 100 and had graded performance in line with national averages. The validated data released in December recorded 99.9 and left the comparison grade at a D (below national averages).

### **Key Stage 3 (Provisional)**

5. The 2005 results for individual schools will be available in the Key Stage 3 Attainment and Achievement Tables to be published in March 2006. Provisional results are contained in Appendix 3 (attached).

In 2005, the Key Stage 3 results in all core subjects rose. English by 7.1% from 2004 figures, mathematics by 2% and science by 4%. The English results for 2005 exceeded the schools' aggregated target by 1.3%.

English and mathematics standards (Level 5+) have consistently improved from 2001 to 2005, with English 2005 results matching the national average and mathematics being 1% below. Standards have risen more steadily in science, but in 2005 were just 1% below the national average. Standards in ICT improved from 2001 to 2004, dipped in 2005, but remain 2% above the national average. 50% of secondary schools recorded improved results in the three core subjects (English, mathematics and science), comparing 2004 and 2005 results.

Comparison with statistical neighbours (Level 5+) shows English has improved two places to 4/11, mathematics has maintained 6/11 and science has declined one position to 5/11 (2004 and 2005 results). In 2004, mathematics and science Average Point Scores were in line with statistical neighbours and national averages. English was in line with national but below statistical

neighbours. Value added measures from 2002 to 2004 show a slight decline from 100 to 99.7.

The percentage of 5+ A\* - C grades increased in 2005 by 3.2%. However, the gap between Dudley and national results widened. The percentage of pupils attaining 5+ A\* - G remains above the national average.

A new measure of performance is to include English and mathematics results. The percentage of 5+ A\* - C (including English and mathematics) for Dudley in 2005 was 41.2%. This was the best performance in the Black Country. This represents an improvement over three years, though it remains below the national average of 44.9%. The percentage of 5+ A\* - G figures indicate Dudley achieved above the national average. Pupil progress, measured by value added scores, indicates that Dudley pupils made better progress than pupils nationally.

### **Key Stage 5**

7. The Dudley Average Point Score per student and per examination are above the Black Country average but below the national average. However, the gap between the national and local average has narrowed over the period 2004 – 2005. Results at Bishop Milner School showed a substantial improvement in 2005, compared with 2004. OFSTED is monitoring the sixth form at Ellowes Hall School, which was judged to be unsatisfactory when it received its last full inspection in November 2004. The school was judged to be making good progress with its activities to address the key issues in that report (Tables 12 and 13).
