Rag Bag is an initiative to raise funds for charity by recycling textiles and shoes.

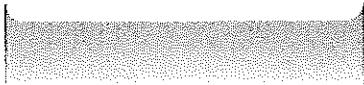

The initiative has been extremely successful, raising over £200,000 for schools by hundreds of tonnes of unwanted textiles.

The scheme has been so successful that we are now working in partnership with local authorities to promote a Rag Bag House Collection Initiative.

Textiles clothing and shoes are collected directly from your door, recycled and fun for charity.

We collect and recycle all textiles clothing and shoes. Everything we collect will be recycled here in the UK.
