- (i) Plan no. P06/0162 – Land adjacent to Dudley Road and Dreadnought Road, Pensnett Trading Estate, Kingswinford – Felling of 31 trees of various species

Decision: Approved, subject to conditions numbered 1 to 4 (inclusive), as set out in the report of the Director of the Urban Environment.

- (ii) Plan no. P06/0165 – Land adjacent to Dudley Road and Dreadnought Road, Pensnett Trading Estate, Kingswinford – Pruning of various trees of different species

Decision: Approved, subject to conditions numbered 2, 3 and 4, as set out in the report of the Director of the Urban Environment and an amended condition, numbered 1, as follows:

1. Notwithstanding any of the details on the submitted application forms, prior to the carrying out of the works, a detailed work specification shall be agreed in writing with the Local Planning Authority for all of the planned operations to the trees situated within the areas referred to as Compartment 2 and the woodland screening adjacent to Dreadnought Road in this application.

- (iii) Plan no. P06/0326 – 33, 35, 39 and 55 Leys Road, 10, 21, 29, 47 and 30 Leys Crescent, Brockmoor, Brierley Hill – Prune 1 Ash tree, pollard 8 Lime trees and fell 1 Birch tree

Decision: Approved, subject to the conditions numbered 1 to 5, as set out in the report of the Director of the Urban Environment and that the applicants be invited to submit a further application for felling.
