**REPORT OF THE DIRECTOR OF LAW AND PROPERTY
AND THE DIRECTOR OF FINANCE**

REVISION OF LICENCE FEES

PURPOSE

1. To consider the revision of fees for licences and consents (other than those where the fees are imposed by statute and in respect of cinemas) administered by the Committee

BACKGROUND

2. The fees for the various licences and permits administered by the Committee were last revised with effect from April 2005.
3. Fees received in respect of all licences or consents, are currently refunded if the application is withdrawn or refused.
4. In considering the revision of licence fees, the Sub-Committee may wish to compare the fees charged by the Council with those of neighbouring Councils. A table showing these comparisons is attached as Appendix 1.
5. Column (1) in Table A below shows the fees currently charged.

Column (2) in Table A shows the effect on fees of an inflation increase of 2%.

Column (3) shows the effect on fees of an increase of inflation plus 1%.

Column (4) shows the effect on fees of an increase of inflation plus 2%.

Column (5) shows the effect on fees of an increase of inflation plus 3%.

6. The Council is only permitted to charge licensing fees up to the amount that can be ascertained as being the cost of administering the licensing function. This includes enforcement, the administrative and ancillary costs of issuing the licence and the ancillary costs relating to members meeting to determine certain licensing applications.
7. An extensive comparison of fees exercise was undertaken by the Licensing Officer as part of the Best Value Review process. This exercise highlighted differences in fees across approximately 30 neighbouring authorities. Dudley's licensing fees bore favourable comparison with all other authorities. It is important however, to note that the Best Value Review Team took the view that the fee comparison exercise did not reflect both quality and public safety issues.

PROPOSAL

8. That the Sub-Committee review the fees for those licences and consents set out in paragraph 5 of this report to take effect from 1st April 2006.
