The Club shall be called HALESOWEN & HASBURY CLUB

OBJECTS

The objects of the Club are to provide social and recreational facilities for members.

CONSTITUTION

The Club is a proprietary club and the Proprietor is **WESTBOURNE LEISURE LTD**

The proprietor will provide the Club with the Club premises and all reasonable necessities and facilities for carrying on the Club in accordance with its objectives and these Rules. The Proprietor will be responsible for all expenses connected herewith with for the engagement, dismissal and payment of staff, and all other matters which involve the disbursement of money.

GENERAL COMMITTEE

The general committee shall exercise the powers of management. The constitution of the General Committee shall be as follows -

- The Club Manager as appointed from time to time by the Proprietor.
- Not more than three nominated members from time to time appointed by the Proprietor.
- The Proprietor may determine the duration of a nominated members term of office.

Any two members of the General Committee shall form a quorum

PROPOSAL FOR CANDIDATES FOR MEMBERSHIP

Every candidate for membership must be at least 18 years of age and shall be proposed by one member of the Club and the proposal must be seconded by another member, both of which members shall vouch for the candidate's fitness for membership. The names and addresses of candidates, together with those of their proposers and seconders shall be posted for a period of 24 hours in the Club. A sub-committee comprising two members may elect a member at any time, but such election may be annulled at the next meeting of the General Committee. No reason shall be given to any candidate in the event of his rejection. The officers of the Club are members of the Club for as long as they hold office.

SUBSCRIPTIONS

The annual subscription (if any) for members shall be such sum as the Proprietor decides. The Proprietor shall in his absolute discretion decide the price of admission (if any) of guests to be charged in addition to the annual subscription.

MEMBERSHIP

When an elected candidate has paid his first subscription (if any) and has undertaken to be bound by the Club rules and any byelaws made or to be made in accordance therewith, he shall be a member of the Club. If the election of a member is annulled by the General Committee as provided by these Rules, he shall cease to be a member and his subscription shall be returned.

Temporary membership shall be afforded to members of a team, their officials and supporters visiting the premises for the express purpose of fulfilling an organised sporting fixture.

RIGHTS AND LIABILITIES

Every member of the Club shall be subject to the rules and bye-laws for the time being in force, and by their membership agree to be bound by such rules and bye-laws and shall be entitled to use and enjoy in common with other members of the Club, the Club premises and the things therein provided by the Proprietor for the use of the Club, but shall not by reason of his membership be under any financial liability to the Proprietor except for payment of his annual subscription (if any) and admission charges (if any) and the use of other facilities of the Club. The General Committee shall have the right of control in the absolute discretion over admission and rejection of members or their guests from the Club premises and such right may be exercised by any member or employee acting with authority delegated to them by the Proprietor.

GUESTS

No guests shall be allowed except that a member may introduce and entertain on any one occasion three guests aged 18 years or over at the Club and there shall be kept at the Club premises a Visitors Book in which both the member and guest shall sign. The introducing member shall be responsible for his guest(s) observing the Club rules and regulations. The General committee may suspend any member who takes advantage of his privileges to the detriment of the Club. No person whose membership has been terminated or whose application for membership has ever been rejected shall at any time be introduced as a guest.

BYE-LAWS

The General Committee may from time to time make, vary and revoke Byelaws not inconsistent with the rules for the regulation of the internal affairs of the Club and conduct of members. Any dispute or difference which shall arise regarding the interpretation of the rules or bye-laws shall be interpreted by the Proprietor whose decision shall be final and binding on all parties.

INTOXICATING LIQUOR

Intoxicating liquor shall not be sold to any person who has not been a member of the Club for at least 24 hours, but subject to any conditions imposed by the premises licence this shall not forbid the provision of intoxicating liquor for consumption by a guest introduced to the club or to a candidate for membership who has been admitted to the Club premises, either as a guest of a member or by permission of one of the members of General Committee

The Proprietor shall maintain membership of Pubwatch where a local scheme continues to exist and abide by the rules, decisions and policies of such scheme.

DISSOLUTION

The Club may be dissolved at any time by the Proprietor without incurring any liability on its behalf or on the General Committee to the members.

SUPPLEMENTARY

The Rules may be revoked, supplemented or altered by the Proprietors except that upon such revocation, supplementation or alteration written notice shall be given to the Licensing Authority to the Chief Officer of Police.

The Proprietor accepts no responsibility for loss of or damage to property of any member of guests on the club premises or otherwise.

Opening hours shall be such as laid down from time to time by the Proprietor in accordance with the provisions of the Licensing Act 2003

GAMING MACHINES

Any profits derived from the gaming machines shall be included on the overall profit of the Club and thereby benefiting the members generally


