

The Government's Mandate to the NHS Commissioning Board sets out

"The NHS Commissioning Board's objective is to ensure that CCG's work with local authorities to ensure that vulnerable people, particularly those with learning disabilities and autism, receive safe, appropriate, high quality care.

The presumption should always be that services are local and that people remain in their communities; we expect to see a substantial reduction in reliance on inpatient care for these groups of people"
