The fare is shown on the taximeter, which records on a basis of time and distance at the following rates.

MILEAGE

For the first 91.43 yards or part.....	£1.50
For each subsequent 91.43 yards or part (until 731.44 yards have been travelled).....	20p
For each subsequent 224.20 yards or part there of.....	20p

WAITING TIME (per hour).....	£13.21
For each 54.5 seconds – equivalent to	20p

EXTRA CHARGES

For hirings begun between 2300 and 0600.....	50p
For hirings on Sundays and Bank Holidays between 0600 and 2300.....	50p
For hirings on Christmas Day and between the hours of 0001 and 0600 on New Years Day.....	Double Meter Charges
For hirings on Boxing Day only.....	£3.00 levy on all journeys
For every article of luggage conveyed outside the passenger compartment of the carriage.....	20p
For every person over the age of seven years in excess of one.....	20p

Barrier Charges (New Street Station).....	20p
An additional fare may be charged in the event of soilage or Fouling of the vehicle.....	Additional Fare £30.00

COMPLAINTS

Enquiries regarding property accidentally left in a Taxi should be made to the nearest West Midlands Police Station.

If you fail to pay the fare recorded on the meter you may be liable under the Theft Act 1968, on conviction, to a sentence of imprisonment of up to 10 years.
