 - Commission joint services when appropriate

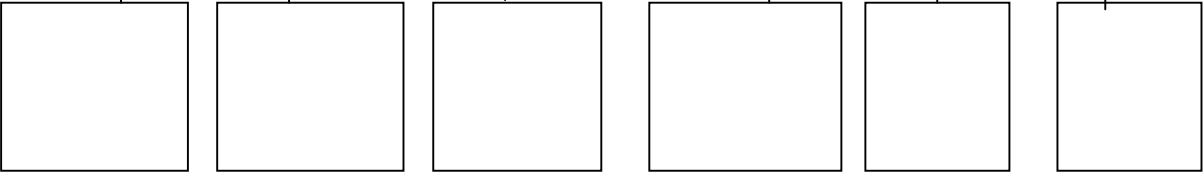
