Purpose of Report

1. To report to the Forum the use of the centrally held school specific contingencies in 2004/05.

Background

- 2. The purpose of the contingency is, in general terms, to provide for in year allocations for significant in year increase in pupil numbers, in-year changes in floor area, interest on carry-forward balances, school-based emergencies, union duties, premature retirements and redundancies and other initiatives and emergencies which is difficult for an individual school to cater for from within their delegated budget.
- 3. Details of the expenditure for 2004/05 are included on the attached appendix 1, which indicates that the budget of £667,672 was overspent by £273,485; this balance will be rolled forward and recovered from the 2005/06 budget allocation.
