BLACK COUNTRY WASTE MANAGEMENT STUDY

PURPOSE OF REPORT

1. To provide an interim report to Committee on the progress of the Black Country Waste Management Study.

BACKGROUND

- 2. The four Black Country Councils have jointly commissioned a Waste Management Study to identify a waste management strategy for the mid to long term.
- 3. The project is being supported by the Government Office of the West Midlands, as it is of regional significance and will link into the major Black Country Study currently being undertaken.
- 4. A presentation will be made to the meeting that will set out the main issues in greater detail.
