# Report of the Area Liaison Officer

# **Co-opted Members**

### **Purpose of Report**

1. To consider the appointment of co-opted members for 2008/9.

#### **Background**

- 2. For 2007/8 the Area Committee appointed the following co-opted members: -
  - Mr G Downing Local Businesses
  - Mr I Green Voluntary Community Sector
  - Ms P Shepherd Local Tenants and Residents
  - Mr K Rodney (and in his absence Mr P Singh) Ethnic Minorities
  - Ryan Nokes Young People (appointed on the 10<sup>th</sup> March 2008).
- 3. Mr G Downing and Mr K Rodney have both indicated their willingness to be coopted again for 2008/9.
- 4. When appointed at the March 2008 meeting Ryan Nokes asked that he be permitted to appoint a substitute for any meeting that he was unable to attend.
- 5. Both Mr I Green and Ms P Shepherd were not able to attend many meetings during 2007/8 because of ill health. At the time of writing this report I am still awaiting nominations from Stourbridge Community Associations Network and the Stourbridge Area Forum.
- 6. Members are reminded that the Protocol for Area Committees permits the Area Committee to co-opt up to 5 persons onto the committee for the period expiring with the conclusion of a municipal year. Co-opted members are entitled to speak at meetings but not to vote.
- 7. The Protocol requires that the committee, in appointing co-opted members, must have due regard to the extent to which persons to be co-opted represent interests of importance within the communities served by the committee. There is a further requirement that co-optees shall not represent the views of any political party on the committee. Furthermore, the committee has previously decided that co-optees must not be employed by the Council or be members of a political party.

#### **Finance**

8. Co-opted members are entitled to receive travelling and subsistence allowances in accordance with Section 174 of the Local Government Act 1972 and a Financial Loss Allowance in accordance with Section 173(4) of that Act.

#### Law

9. Section 102(3) of the Local Government Act 1972, enables the Committee to appoint co-opted members.

## **Equality Impact**

10. This report complies fully with the Council's policies on equality and diversity. The views of young people are represented through the appointment of one of the co-opted members.

#### Recommendation

11. It is recommended that the Area Committee consider the appointment of coopted members for 2008/9.
