<b>Purpose of the report</b>	<b>To provide the Health and Well-being board (H&amp;WBB) with an update on the refresh of the JSNA process</b>
<b>Key points to note</b>	<p>Current and future health and wellbeing priorities for the population of Dudley are identified through the Joint Strategic Needs Assessment process that was introduced in 2007. Responsibility for the JSNA passed to the Health and Wellbeing Board in April 2013. A sub group of the Board was established to take on this responsibility.</p> <p>Following a presentation of the outcomes of a review of the JSNA process, it was agreed at the September 2015 Board meeting that the following items be developed and presented to the December Board meeting:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• terms of reference for a revised JSA sub-group</li> <li>• an implementation plan for the JSA group</li> <li>• a draft of the design of a consistent JSA process</li> <li>• examples of proposed JSA products</li> </ul>
