Dear Mr Jacobs,

Regarding closure of Footpath C62 from Church Road to Summerhill Road, Coseley.

On 14th May I received an E-mail from Emma Kerrigan informing me that crime in the area had dropped. I can only assume that there has now been rise in crime in the area. In my opinion the closure will merely move any criminal activity to areas immediately outside the gates in other words putting it on the street.

I have further been informed by Surina Bagria that due to an administration error that there is a further consultative period from 4th December 2008 to 10th January 2009 in the interest of fairness and that it is best to register my objections once again.

I wish to reinstate my concerns that the gating procedure will adversely affect the trade of my tenant Mrs L Lake at the General Store on Summerhill Road because many of her customers come to the shop via the footpath. If they cannot use this it will involve a much longer prohibitive journey.

I am also concerned that placing a gate at the rear of the shops will provide a means whereby burglars can climb into the rear fenced area.

I have asked before if a key to the gates can be provided so that the footpath may be opened during shop hours.

I would like to receive a reply on these matters in the interest of fairness. Can you reassure me that my E-mail will reach Dudley Access Forum and Councillor Adams?
